SARS-CoV-2 Epidemiology And Response In Children

- Researchers at **Johns Hopkins University** are working with the **CDC** to learn about **COVID-19 disease** in households with young children
- **Who is eligible?**
 - Households with at least one child **under 5 years old**
- **What to expect?**
 - The study will follow families for 8 months
 - Participants will:
 - Complete brief weekly surveys on a smartphone or computer
 - Collect nose swabs each week and mouth swabs each month at home; mail swabs to the study lab in pre-paid packaging
 - Have blood drawn by our study nurses 3 or 4 times at your pediatrician's office or Hopkins clinic
 - Receive information about COVID-19 infection in your household
- **How can this research make a difference?**
 - This research can teach us about how COVID-19 affects families, and help us think about ways to protect them
